Re: Forest Service Parity in Field Unit Local Hiring (Sec. 125)

Chair Merkley and Ranking Member Murkowski,

On behalf of the millions of trail users we represent and as organizations that cooperatively manage the National Trails System trails, we thank the Committee for advancing legislation to fund our nation's trails and public lands to ensure they are open and accessible for all.

We greatly appreciate the inclusion of Sec. 125, Field Unit Local Hiring, to address the authority of the Department of the Interior for direct hiring authority for Local Field Units. We request that this authority be extended to the USDA Forest Service. As the nation's other main land management agency, the Forest Service is facing the same hiring challenges as the Department of the Interior and should be provided the same authority under this section.

The inclusion of the USDA Forest Service is consistent with S. 5125,the *Land Manager Housing* and *Workforce Improvement Act*, recently introduced by Senators Barrasso, King, and Daines.

We ask for your leadership in assuring the USDA Forest Service is included in this provision in the final enacted FY25 Interior and Related Agencies bill.
