Re: Comments on Draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement for Utility-Scale Solar Energy Development

Dear Jeremy,

Outdoor Alliance, The Conservation Alliance, and the Outdoor Industry Association (the "Protecting America's Outdoors Coalition") appreciate the opportunity to comment on the Draft Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement for Utility-Scale Solar Development (Solar PEIS) prepared by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). The human-powered outdoor recreation community, the outdoor industry, and conservation-minded businesses support the BLM's work to balance renewable energy development with other public lands values, including sustainable outdoor recreation access. These comments outline our perspectives on the PEIS, including requested changes to the Action Alternatives that will help BLM reduce recreation-related conflicts with solar energy, thereby expediting the agency's work to address the climate crisis.

Our comments are divided into three sections:

First, we have provided a high-level overview of recreation values on BLM lands throughout the planning area and how solar planning might affect these values. As advocates for recreation access, healthy climate-resilient landscapes, and clean energy, we are hopeful that the Final PEIS will aid BLM planners in sustaining and advancing these important public lands values simultaneously.

Second, we ask that additional lands with recreation values be excluded from solar development in all of the Action Alternatives. This request is based on a geographic information systems (GIS) inventory completed by the Outdoor Alliance GIS Lab that found significant human-powered recreation resources including rivers, trails, and climbing areas within the Solar Application Areas in all Action Alternatives. This analysis is described in more detail below in Section 2, as well as in Appendix 1. We have also provided a list of these recreation sites in Appendix 2.

Third, we have also provided more general comments and recommendations to inform the final PEIS, which are intended to help BLM better align solar development with recreation management and reduce potential recreation-related conflicts at the project level. Our requests include:

- Additional Programmatic Design Features for outdoor recreation to require more robust stakeholder outreach and guide potential mitigation activities;
- Consider whether the Preferred Alternative could be refined to more strategically guide solar development;
- Consider whether outdated Resource Management Plans (RMPs) pose barriers to solar energy planning;
- Integrate the Solar PEIS with the BLM's Blueprint for 21st Century Outdoor Recreation and, when finalized, the Public Lands Rule; and
- Evaluate how solar development might affect dispersed camping, an important and widely-practiced recreation opportunity on BLM lands.

These comments are inspired in part by our community's strong desire to see renewable development move forward expeditiously to support a society-wide clean energy transition and to help enhance the role of public lands as climate solutions. By addressing outdoor recreation at the programmatic level, the BLM can ensure that needed renewable energy projects move forward with broad public support without unnecessarily harming recreation values or the nation's \$1.1 trillion outdoor recreation economy.

Our comments are outlined in more detail below.

1. Outdoor Recreation in the Solar PEIS Planning Area

Outdoor recreation is integral to the quality of life for both visitors and residents throughout the 11-state Solar PEIS planning area. BLM lands throughout the planning area include some of America’s most iconic recreation destinations, as well as countless lesser-known recreation sites that are used for hiking, mountain biking, paddling, climbing, and other recreational activities. Of note, BLM lands tend to provide a relatively undeveloped outdoor recreation experience that, as the agency recently acknowledged in its Blueprint for 21st Century Outdoor Recreation, is defined “by the natural, geological, and culture resources the agency manages and the relative freedom people enjoy shaping their own experiences.”¹ This experience is facilitated not only through access to trails and other recreation sites, but also through recreationists’ ability to explore less traveled BLM lands, including through cross-country travel, dispersed camping, and more.

Recreation is also an important economic driver throughout the planning area. According to the Bureau of Economic Analysis, in 2022 outdoor recreation accounted for 1.9% of state GDP in New Mexico, 2.5% in Arizona, 2% in California, 2.7% in Nevada, 3.2% in Utah, 2.8% in Colorado, 4.1% in Wyoming, 4.3% in Montana, 3.1% in Idaho, 2.5% in Oregon, and 2.7% in Washington.² Access to recreation opportunities on public lands, including BLM lands, lays the foundation for recreation-related economic development throughout the planning area.

While our community generally supports thoughtfully-sited solar development, this development can nonetheless degrade the outdoor experience in a number of ways. As the PEIS acknowledges, recreation access is excluded from solar energy facilities, and while transmission infrastructure does not necessarily preclude access, it can alter the character of the recreation experience by introducing a form of industrial infrastructure (and associated visual and acoustic impacts) to an otherwise undeveloped landscape.³ Solar energy can alter viewsheds enjoyed by recreationists by introducing development that contrasts strongly with the

surrounding landscape. In some cases, these visual impacts extend to lands not administered by BLM such as National Parks, National Forests, and State Parks.

Many recreational activities on BLM lands occur on protected lands such as National Conservation Lands that are excluded from development by the PEIS' Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria. According to the Draft PEIS, these protected landscapes account for approximately 62% of recreational use on BLM lands.⁴ A portion of the remaining 38% of recreational activities would be open for solar development in all alternatives considered by the Draft PEIS.

The Draft PEIS acknowledges that solar facilities might eliminate access to legal off-highway vehicle routes designated through travel management planning.⁵ Many legal OHV routes are also enjoyed by non-motorized recreational users and can be important for accessing remote recreation sites like climbing areas. Further, if BLM envisions solar facilities leading to motorized trail closures, we assume that this might also extend to non-motorized trails. To help mitigate the likelihood that these closures occur, we ask that BLM exclude the recreation lands described below in Section 2 and also provide guidance for local land managers to identify possible recreation conflicts. As we outline in Section 3, BLM should also require mitigation to address the impacts of potential closures on recreation access.

2. Request for Additional Recreation Exclusion Criteria

We appreciate that the list of proposed Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria common to all Action Alternatives excludes valuable recreation lands such as Special Recreation Management Managements Areas (SRMs), National Conservation Lands, National Recreation Trails, and developed recreational facilities, as well as numerous conservation designations. However, these recreation resources are not comprehensive and do not capture all trails, climbing areas, rivers, and other resources that recreationists use and value on BLM lands. In order to reduce potential conflicts between solar development and outdoor recreation, we ask that the BLM include the recreation resources identified by Outdoor Alliance (and described below) in the Exclusion Criteria common to all alternatives.

Outdoor Alliance maintains the most comprehensive—though necessarily incomplete—geospatial data set of human-powered outdoor recreation resources on public lands and waters. Using the Solar PEIS data provided by BLM,⁶ a GIS analysis of Alternative 3 reveals that the Solar Application Areas contain:

- Portions of 111 multi-use BLM trails (select open to biking), totaling 75 miles;⁷
- Portions of 569 other multi-use trails (select open to biking), totaling 506 miles,⁸
- Portions of 26 other multi-use trails (closed to biking), totaling 10 miles;
- 14 climbing sites totaling 132 climbing routes and boulder problems;
- 6 river access points;
- Portions of 20 whitewater river runs, totaling 24 miles.

We have provided a list of these recreation sites in Appendix 2. We will also be submitting GIS data identifying additional proposed exclusion areas along with our comments. The proposed recreation exclusion layer is derived from Outdoor Alliance's Recreation Footprint, which is described in detail below in Appendix 1.⁹ We ask that BLM include this layer in the Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria common to all alternatives.

These areas may fall into Extensive Recreation Management Areas (ERMAs) or other undesignated lands that are managed for remote and undeveloped character. Placing a potential developed solar site in close proximity to these recreation assets would undermine their value and purpose. Therefore these ERMAs and other lands that host recreation assets should also warrant full or partial exclusion where a solar development could interfere with and detract from the purposes, settings and characteristics of an ERMA or the outcome based setting of that trail or other recreation asset.

3. Other Comments and Recommendations on BLM's Proposed Solar Planning Approach

Our organizations support the overarching planning approach prescribed by the Solar PEIS, including the use of Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria and incorporating expected transmission infrastructure into solar planning. We offer the following comments on specific aspects and sections of the Draft PEIS:

Include Additional Programmatic Design Features: We appreciate the Programmatic Design Features included to protect recreation values, particularly the requirement that project developers consult with BLM in the early stages of project planning to identify recreation resources in and around a particular site and the requirement that recreation impacts be analyzed in project-level environmental analysis.¹⁰ We also recommend that the Final PEIS include Programmatic Design Features to achieve the following outcomes:

- In addition to coordination between project developers and BLM, the final PEIS should require stakeholder outreach early in project planning to identify recreation values that may be affected. In some cases, BLM staff may be unaware of the full extent of recreation activities on BLM lands in their districts. Outreach to local governments, non-governmental organizations, and others involved will ensure that recreation resources are considered in a comprehensive and timely manner.

- Require mitigation measures to address impacts to public access (particularly trails designated through travel management planning), physical damage to recreation sites, and impacts to viewsheds. The Final PEIS should provide guidance for project developers to mitigate impacts to recreation resources, such as by requiring rerouting of trails closed due to solar development. This should include mitigation actions to address impacts to viewsheds from popular recreation sites.

Scale of Proposal: The Reasonably Foreseeable Development Scenario (RFDS) identified in the Draft PEIS estimates that 697,809 acres of BLM lands will be needed to support solar development through 2045. While we understand the utility in making a wide range of areas available for solar development to provide for flexibility in development possibilities, we question whether several of the Action Alternatives cover too large an area to create efficiencies in guiding solar development at the project level by eliminating potential resource conflicts. Even the most restrictive alternative (Alternative 5) would provide more than twelve times the area needed to support the RFDS, while the agency's preferred alternative (Alternative 3) would make available more than thirty-two times the area needed for the RFDS.

Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria: Our organizations appreciate the list of Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria and support this list (with suggested additions noted in Section 2 above) being retained and expanded upon in the Final PEIS. We are concerned, however, that many of the designations listed in the criteria stem from RMPs, many of which are outdated and may not reflect current on-the-ground conditions. According to agency budget justifications, 134 of BLM's 169 RMPs are outdated.¹¹ This reliance on outdated plans has particular implications for outdoor recreation, which has grown considerably in both size and diversity since many RMPs were finalized. To mitigate the impacts to resource values not recognized in older RMPs, we recommend incorporating additional criteria—including the recreation criteria described in Section 2 of these comments—that do not stem from RMPs, or that can serve as a placeholder before updated RMPs are finalized.

We also encourage BLM to consider including a mechanism in the Final PEIS that would allow for PEIS Solar Application Areas to be updated as RMPs are finalized. This would account for changes to land designations such as ACECs made by planners to address modern resource concerns (changes in wildlife populations, for example). Some recent RMP revisions, such as the draft Rock Springs RMP in Wyoming, have altered land designation boundaries considerably, including by expanding ACECs. Allowing for the Solar PEIS to be updated as these RMPs are completed would ensure that solar planning is based on the most up-to-date resource considerations possible.

Draft PEIS Alternatives: We are most supportive of the alternatives that would concentrate solar development in areas within ten miles of existing and proposed transmission lines with capacities of 100 kV or greater. Considering the vast scale of the planning area, including the transmission infrastructure criteria is helpful for planners and stakeholders to better understand where solar projects will actually be proposed. We also generally support the concept of limiting solar development to disturbed lands, as is proposed in Alternatives 4 and 5, though we note that in many cases the presence of invasive species does not categorically degrade or affect the recreation values of a particular area. For these reasons, we are most supportive of Alternatives 3 and 5.

Integration with BLM Recreation Blueprint: Our organizations support the BLM's work to modernize recreation management as outlined in the Blueprint for 21st Century Outdoor Recreation (the "Blueprint").¹² The Final PEIS should consider how solar development might support or impede the Blueprint's goals. For example, BLM might support the Blueprint's Strategic Pillar #2, Prioritize and Embrace Partnerships, by formalizing a partnership with recreation stakeholders to identify recreation values in project-level solar planning. As another example, adopting additional recreation-focused Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria (as suggested in Section 2 of these comments) would directly support the Blueprint's goal 4(A) to "Develop Sustainable and Equitable Recreation Management Plans and Integrate Recreation Needs and Opportunities in Land Use Planning."¹³

Integration with Proposed BLM Public Lands Rule: The Final PEIS should consider how solar planning can be aligned with the BLM's final Conservation and Landscape Health Rule (Public Lands Rule), which is expected to be finalized in spring or summer 2024 (prior to the release of the Final PEIS). Multiple aspects of the draft Public Lands Rule, such as land health assessments, hold potential to advance the goals of the Solar PEIS and might inform how local land managers consider solar proposals and develop necessary mitigation. As an example, the proposed rule's updated criteria for designating Areas of Critical Environmental Concern (ACECs) would directly affect solar availability across all Action Alternatives because ACECs are included in the Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria. Additionally, the Public Lands Rule's proposed system of conservation leases will likely affect areas where solar facilities might be sited, and conservation leasing could also provide opportunities for mitigating solar impacts.

Dispersed Camping: Dispersed camping is a widely-practiced and important form of recreation on BLM lands that is not addressed explicitly in the Draft PEIS or included in Outdoor Alliance's proposed exclusion layer. Many recreationists seek out the relatively undeveloped, free camping opportunities present on BLM lands, and in many cases these areas provide needed lodging opportunities when developed camping sites—including on neighboring Forest Service and Park Service lands—are at capacity. While recognizing that excluding these areas entirely from availability under the Solar PEIS is impractical, we recommend that BLM and project developers analyze impacts to popular dispersed camping areas when evaluating solar proposals at the project level.

Visual Resources: In the Scoping summary, regarding Visual Resources, the BLM notes that "commenters note that large-scale solar development is presenting a new level of challenge for scenery management and visual impacts and stressed that visual concerns should be considered during planning in order to avoid destroying the visual beauty of the land. They recommended that the BLM should update visual resource management classifications". We share these concerns and feel they reinforce our comments that the undeveloped nature of remote trails outside designated areas are also worth protecting and should be carefully considered when evaluating potential solar development.

Appendix 1: Background Information and Methodology for Outdoor Alliance Recreation Data

In addition to these comments, Outdoor Alliance is submitting nine Geographic Information Systems (GIS) layers to the BLM to be considered alongside our comments. These layers consist of:

1. Eight human-powered outdoor recreation layers included in Alternative 3's Solar Application Areas. These sites are derived from Outdoor Alliance's recreation database, which includes data from federal agencies, states, and Outdoor Alliance data partners.
2. One layer of proposed Recreation Exclusion Areas. These areas represent the overlap between Alternative 3 Solar Application Areas and Outdoor Alliance's "Recreation Footprint" (described below). As we outline in our comments, we ask that these exclusion areas be added to the Resource-Based Exclusion Criteria common to all alternatives.

The proposed exclusions cover 217,709 acres throughout the Alternative 3 Solar Application Areas. Excluding these areas from potential solar development will help minimize conflicts with recreation resources during future project-level solar planning.

The section below describes the purpose and methodology behind the Recreation Footprint.

Recreation Footprint 2024 Documentation

Introduction

Outdoor Alliance is a coalition of ten member-based organizations representing the human-powered outdoor recreation community. The coalition includes Access Fund, American Canoe Association, American Whitewater, International Mountain Bicycling Association, Winter Wildlands Alliance, The Mountaineers, the American Alpine Club, the Mazamas, Colorado Mountain Club, and Surfrider Foundation and

represents the interests of the millions of Americans who climb, paddle, mountain bike, backcountry ski and snowshoe, and enjoy coastal recreation on our nation's public lands, waters, and snowscapes.

The western United States includes tens of thousands of recreational assets that support human-powered recreation experiences. This analysis, entitled "The Recreation Footprint" identifies a subset of these recreational assets in 12 western states including Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, Oregon, Washington, and Wyoming. The footprint encompasses trails, climbing areas, whitewater paddling runs, and developed recreation sites, buffered by ¼ mile. The buffered area recognizes the importance of setting, including attributes like viewsheds and soundscapes, for recreational pursuits. The footprint reflects a mix of public data sources and reliable proprietary data from trusted data partners.

The steps Outdoor Alliance took to create the recreation footprint are below.

Process

Outdoor Alliance used three primary steps to create the 2024 Recreation Footprint:

1. The recreation footprint includes the USA Federal Lands Feature Layer derived from Esri's ArcGIS Online catalog, which was used to outline the boundaries for the federal land agencies within each of the western states listed above. Although many federal land agencies are responsible for managing outdoor recreation, Outdoor Alliance focused this analysis on the recreation resources that fall within the jurisdictions of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), U.S. Forest Service (USFS), and National Park Service (NPS). Publicly available trail and recreation site data for the BLM, USFS, and NPS comes from ArcGIS Online, Esri's Living Atlas, and the BLM's Geospatial Hub. The trail datasets were queried to include trails that are characteristic of the types that our user groups most often

use¹⁴. Additionally, if the trail use type is characterized as being exclusive to motorized use only, those trails are excluded from the analysis. Many trails have a shared use that includes both motorized and non-motorized use on the same trail. Trails that were labeled as “shared” in the datasets were included in the analysis. Similar to the trail data, the recreation footprint includes site data for sites that are characteristic of the types that our community most often uses.¹⁵ The specific attributes that are associated with the trail and recreation datasets are shown in Appendix A.

2. Outdoor Alliance manages a database¹⁶ with the best available data of human-powered recreation resources, including trails (hike, bike, and ski), climbing areas, whitewater runs, and river access points through data-use partnerships with entities including onX Backcountry and American Whitewater. These datasets are delivered to Outdoor Alliance in a CSV format requiring additional processing to accurately convert the coordinate data into a workable file in a GIS project. These datasets are specific to one recreational use each and do not require the same querying processes as the federal datasets do as described in footnotes 1 and 2.
3. After all the datasets are queried to display each recreation use layer based on the criteria outlined in the footnotes and are summarized within the federal land boundaries, a ¼-mile buffer was generated for each of the recreation asset layers. The buffer aligns with the ¼ mile buffer applied to Wild and Scenic Rivers for management planning and reflects that the recreation experience is affected by the broader setting. The resulting buffers are merged together to create one cohesive recreation footprint.
