

**Seattle Canyoning Committee**  
**Volunteer Job Description**  
***At-Large Member***

**Purpose**

At-Large Committee Members provide a range of perspectives on key issues that come before the committee. In addition to playing a key advisory role, At-Large Members assist with Canyoning Committee activities.

**Requirements**

The Committee seeks At-Large Members who have experience with Mountaineers Canyoning Activities as well as relevant experience external to the committee. This may be experience in other Mountaineers activity committees, experience on the Board of Directors, experience in other Canyoning groups, or other relevant experience.

**Term**

October - September

The At-Large Members are elected by Committee vote. The At-Large Members are asked to commit to two years, and may be elected for a second consecutive term.

The At-Large Members are asked to notify the committee of their intent to stay in the position or vacate the position each August for the following year.

**Commitment**

- October - December (10-20 hours total)
  - Attend Committee Meetings
  - Assist with Committee projects as needed
- January - March (10-20 hours total)
  - Attend Committee Meetings
  - Assist with Committee projects as needed
- April - June (10-20 hours total)
  - Attend Committee Meetings
  - Assist with Committee projects as needed
- July - September (10-20 hours total)
  - Attend Committee Meetings
  - Assist with Committee projects as needed

**Duties**

- Attend Committee Meetings
- Volunteer to assist with key projects of interest. This may be courses, surveys or studies, collaborations, or events. It is important that the individuals in these positions remain connected and engaged with Mountaineers Canyoning activities.

**Responsibilities**

- Ensure multiple perspectives are considered in key decisions

- Support areas in the canyoning program that need support for the program to thrive
